NEW TRAFFIC PATTERNS AND PERIODIC LANE CLOSURES ON CAMPBELL BOULEVARD IN WHITE MARSH
Improvements part of I-95 Express Toll LanesSM Project

WHAT: Construction on eastbound or westbound Campbell Boulevard between Honeygo Boulevard and Franklin Square Drive will involve periodic temporary single-lane closures during non-peak hours. The entrance closest to the I-95 overpass into the Nottingham Square shopping center will be closed for left-turning vehicles during the periodic closures of the eastbound lane only. A temporary pedestrian walkway will be installed along the work zone on westbound Campbell Boulevard.

WHEN: Construction begins in June 2012 and is expected to last for approximately two years to spring/summer 2014. The periodic single-lane closures are expected to occur Mondays through Thursdays between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.; Fridays between 9 a.m. and noon; and during overnight hours. No lane or entrance closures are permitted from November 1 to January 31.

Between fall 2013 and spring 2014, a continuous 60-day period is needed for one lane operation on westbound Campbell Boulevard. The first entrance into Nottingham Square also will be closed continuously.

WHY: Work is part of the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) I-95 Express Toll Lanes (ETLsSM) Project and involves the reconstruction/widening of the existing I-95 bridge over Campbell Boulevard. Campbell Boulevard will be widened to five lanes -- two lanes in each direction and a new center left-turn lane into Nottingham Square -- for improved traffic flow. A new pedestrian sidewalk will also be constructed along eastbound Campbell Boulevard.

The Campbell Boulevard improvements are part of the \$142.6 million project underway by Cherry Hill Construction of Jessup, Md., to reconstruct the I-95/MD 43 (White Marsh Boulevard) interchange. Baltimore County is funding the Campbell Boulevard roadway, sidewalk and lighting improvements. The entire I-95 ETLs Project is expected to be complete in 2014.
