Circular Bill Passed on January 1:

As you may or may not know by now, a new bill was passed by Council and went into effect on January 1 regarding circulars delivered to residents. Listed below is a clear description of understanding per Code Enforcement. If you have any further questions regarding this information please contact Code Enforcement directly with any questions. Thanks Cathy

1. Establishments/ businesses have the right to send 2 flyers per year- 1 every 6 months- so we will ask for documentation from the citizen that the establishment has violated that regulation
2. The citizen has to call/notify the establishment if they've received more than 1 within a 6 month period (we'll need documentation/verification that they have in fact called) and request that they be taken off the list. Please remember it's not a violation if they send 1 circular every 6 months.
3. According to the bill the establishment can place the flyers on cars that are on the street- as many times as they want- no limits
4. According to the bill establishments can place on cars in shopping centers
5. Additionally-if the Papa Johns on Reisterstown Rd. sends a flyer one week the Papa Johns on Old Court sends another week, the Papa Johns on Owings Mills Blvd. another week- according to the bill it's all legal- as long as it's only 1 per every 6 months- the citizen can receive 3 Papa Johns circulars all within the same week and it's within the law
6. If the complaint is about the Sunpaper circulars the citizen must cancel their subscription to the Sunpaper-
