Love Local Maryland (LLM) is a WBAL-TV initiative designed to promote local Maryland economies. It is an inclusive program for all businesses, but special emphasis is placed on local businesses by providing a robust web-based sales and marketing tool set, so that businesses can reach out to consumers rather than just wait for them to arrive. The LLM campaign is, in effect, a way to boost the competitive capabilities of Maryland business--particularly important in this time of economic stress.

We are looking for your organization to make its membership aware of the campaign. Businesses can start signing themselves up on the Love Local Maryland active directory. This free directory will include a search engine feature that will allow consumers to find businesses through product and/or service category, key words, zip code and proximity.

Starting in January, the full set of sales and marketing tools including a website, ecoupons, text messaging, email blast, and customer management tool will be available to businesses and the website address will be promoted to consumers by WBAL-TV. Because this is designed for small and medium sized businesses, subscriptions for the tool set are only \$98/year (\$8.16/month, \$0.27/day) for individual businesses. Cooperating organizations have discounted subscriptions for their members. There is no charge for the organizations.

Some of the business associations that have seen the tools have described them as being a true economic stimulus program. It is designed for all kinds of businesses-shops, professional and personal services, home repair providers, landscapers, health care professionals, real estate agents-because it connects customers/clients with businesses. While large companies certainly can benefit from LLM, smaller businesses will be the primary beneficiaries because they will have the same tools that large companies have been using. We all know that when small businesses thrive it means better overall economic conditions.

In the past month, I have received calls from college students and high school seniors asking about the 8th District Senatorial Scholarship program. Awarding scholarships is a responsibility I take very seriously, and I want you to know about the application process.

The 8th District Senatorial Scholarship is awarded based on academic merit, community involvement and financial need. In order to be eligible, you must file your *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) by March 1 of every year. You can learn more about filing a FAFSA here: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>. In addition, you must fill out an application from my office by April 1st. You can receive that form on the scholarship page of my website at <http://kathyforsenate.com/>.

There are two additional requirements for the scholarship program. First, you must be a resident of the 8th district. If you're not sure whether you live in the district, you can find out by visiting <http://www.mdelect.net>. Second, you must attend a Maryland college or university. If you attend an out-of-state school, you must be enrolled in an academic program that is not offered in Maryland, and receive approval from the Maryland Higher Education Commission.

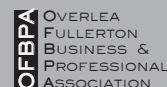
